

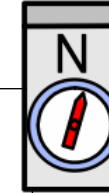


Where do I live and what is special about South Molton?

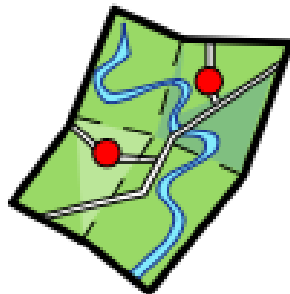

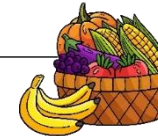

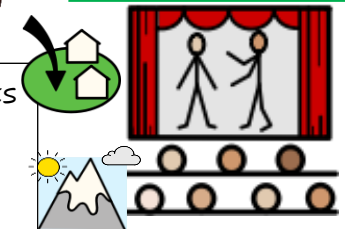
