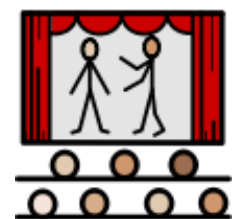

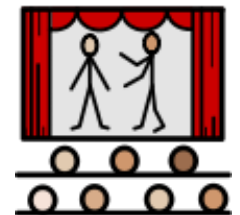

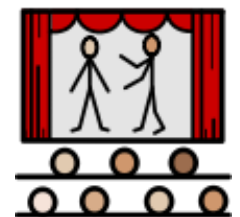

★ **Know why** Christians believe Jesus brings 'good news' in friendship, forgiveness and peace. (Year 2)

★ **Know that** the events of Holy Week take place 33 years after the Nativity. (Year 2)

★ **Know how** Christians believe Jesus rising from death (resurrection) shows them they have a new life with God in heaven after they die. (Year 2)

★ **Know that** Christians believe Jesus came to save or rescue people (Salvation).

★ **Know how** Christians show their beliefs about Palm Sunday, Good Friday and Easter Sunday in worship and other ways.

★ **Know why** Christians call the day Jesus died "Good Friday."
