## Maths

### Using concrete images, pictorial representations and context understand the four operations.

- Number Sense/ Place value- to use different representations to show, order and compare, read and write numbers up to 100. To count forwards and backwards from any given number up to 100 and say 1 more or 1 less.
- Measurement- to measure and record length, capacity, and weight
- Additive Reasoning - to know basic facts to add and subtract mentally including number bonds to 20 and then 20. Add and subtract 1-digit and 2-digit numbers to 20.
- Multiplicative Reasoning- to count in steps of 2s, 5s and 10. Use arrays and other images to show multiplication. To understand the effect of doubling and halving.
- Geometric Reasoning- to recognise and identify basic 2D and 3D- shapes. To understand halves and quarters. Be able to tell the time using o'clock, quarter to, quarter past and half past.
